



## CHARLES E. CRANMER LIQUID TRANSPORTERS, INC SCHOLARSHIP FUND

### Guidelines

#### Objective

In partnership with the University of Kentucky, an endowment scholarship fund is provided to dependent children of active full-time Trimac employees and Independent Contractors. The purpose of this program is to recognize their scholastic achievement and to provide financial assistance as means of encouraging them to proceed to post-secondary education. The basis for selection of the applicants shall be financial need and academic standing.

#### Value and Duration of the Awards

- Up to a maximum of 8 semesters shall be paid for each recipient.

#### Type of Award

- Applicable towards in-state tuition at the University of Kentucky.

#### Requirements for Eligibility

Eligible applicants are unmarried children of:

- active full-time Trimac employees or independent contractors who have completed one or more years of service at the time of application;
- deceased employees who had completed one or more years of service and whose surviving spouse has not remarried at the time the son or daughter is applying for scholarship consideration **AND**
- be a full time student, maintains a 2.5 grade point average and as long as funds remain available from the endowment. If a recipient fails to maintain the required 2.5 grade point average, the scholarship for that recipient shall be forfeited and no further applications shall be accepted from that student.

#### Application Procedures

- Applications must be submitted by **April 15, 2025**

**Students must apply directly to the Office of Student Financial Aid at the University of Kentucky. The selection of applicants for this scholarship will be made by that office.**
