**1976**

Trimac expands into energy services by purchasing Canadian oilfield drilling contractor Kenting Ltd.

**1977**

Trimac's direct investment in oil and gas exploration and production begins with the formation of Tripet Resources.



**1980**

Trimac's energy services expands into the U.S. with the acquisition of the Cactus Drilling, one of the largest purchases in Trimac history.



**1980**

Trucking operations expand south of the border with the purchase of Liquid Transporters Inc. of Louisville, Ky.



**1983**

Trimac begins the Cat Arm hauling project with McNamara Wimpey, marking a financial success and the company's entry into project hauling.



**1983**

Jeff McCaig joins Trimac as Assistant Vice President of Planning and Corporate Development.



**1983**

Trimac opens new corporate headquarters, Trimac House, in Calgary, Alta.



**1984**

Trimac Transportation Inc. (TTI) becomes parent company of all U.S. operations, splitting into western and eastern divisions to develop regional brand.
