Matt Faure is the first person from outside the McCaig family to become President and CEO of Trimac.

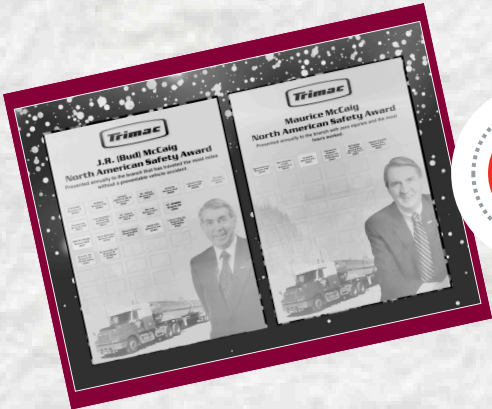
2016

Trimac celebrates 75 years of Service with Safety.



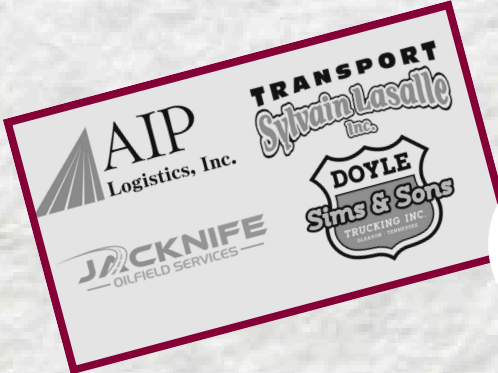
2022
